Here we are at the end of another busy and very successful year. Pre-school is running at full capacity and has a waiting list for new children, so if you have siblings due to start with us in the coming year, please register them as soon as possible.

As you know we continually strive to offer outstanding care and education for our children and to help support our families too. Family support is provided through a range of means, such as helping families in need with emergency food supplies and clothes, supporting parents suffering from mental health and sponsoring children to attend pre-school and provide a hot lunch when family finances are stretched.

We continually look for ways to improve our setting and to enrich the children's learning and experience at pre-school by continuing to update and invest in new equipment and resources and offering an amazing range of activities for the children.

Wherever possible we try to keep costs for our families at a minimum, for example, our recent trip to Wimpole (which took over 300 children and parents/carers for a day out) was provided at a hugely discounted price. We also have a number of visitors attend throughout the year to enrich our curriculum and this is usually provided without any extra charge to our parents and carers.

We believe our high adult: child ratio at our pre-school (which is above government recommendations) enables us to prioritise safety at pre-school and provide a wider range of tailored activities by qualified staff.
