

Eaton Socon Pre-School

Ready for Summer ... Please remember to send your child to pre-school with a hat during the summer term and apply sun cream to them before arriving. Please ensure you check the labelling to ensure your suncream does not contain nut product ingredients (including Prunus Amygdalus Dulcis oil).

Preparing for school...

In preparation for school, we will be exploring dressing up in various school uniforms and using and developing lots of independent skills. Teachers from the local primary schools will also be visiting to meet the children and help them prepare for the transition to school.

Parent's Evening... Our parent consultation evening will take place on Thursday 26th June, from 5:30pm. This will be an opportunity to discuss your child's progress. If your child is leaving us at the end of the term, you will also receive their journal (if you are unable to attend, your child's file will be handed to you at Pre-School from the following day). A letter will be sent out after the half term break so that you can make an appointment.

Day Out... Please be aware there will be no usual pre-school sessions on this day – you will not be charged for sessions on this day. Entrance to the farm will be free for your child and their accompanying parent/carer but if you require coach transport, we ask for a voluntary contribution of £10 towards the cost. Details of the day out will be sent in a letter to you after the half term break.
